STUDY PROGRAM ADAPTED TO THE NEEDS OF THE EUROPEAN POPULATION

Physiotherapy is one of the most sought-after study programs among students in Slovenia. Numerous studies conducted in Europe, including in Slovenia, indicate a significant shortage of physiotherapy graduates and abundant job opportunities both in Slovenia and neighboring countries. The program is aligned with the needs of the European population, aiming to reduce healthcare and rehabilitation costs while ensuring a solid foundation for effective, high-quality physiotherapy work.

The primary goal of the study program is to prepare candidates for graduation in physiotherapy. The program is designed to provide students with theoretical and practical knowledge essential for delivering high-quality care, with focus on prevention, treatment, and rehabilitation for adults and children. Graduates will be qualified to work in public and private healthcare institutions at primary and secondary levels, as well as in community settings.

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

- Completion of secondary education or high school
- Medical examination certificate
- Vaccination certificate

ORGANIZATION OF LESSONS

THEORETICAL LECTURES (online)

Lectures take place via the Zoom platform and can be attended live or watched later.

PRACTICAL LECTURES (ON-SITE)

Practical lessons are held in Maribor, with full (100%) attendance required.

SEMINARS (online)

In addition to theoretical and practical lectures, certain courses include mandatory online seminars.

INTERNSHIP

The internship is a core component of the curriculum each year and can be completed in your home country.

DID YOU KNOW?

The Physiotherapy study program can be continued at the master's level in Health Sciences, specializing in Physiotherapy, and further pursued through a doctoral program in Physiotherapy.



ENROLLMENT PROCESS

The enrollment process consists of two essential steps:

1. PRE-REGISTRATION

Complete the pre-registration on the portal of the Ministry of Education of the Republic of Slovenia at the following link: [eVŠ Prijava]. This step is required to continue with your official university enrollment.

2. OFFICIAL UNIVERSITY ENROLLMENT

Once you have completed the pre-registration, proceed with the official enrollment at the university.

POST-GRADUATION INTERNSHIP AND PROFESSIONAL QUALIFICATION EXAM

After graduation, according to the law of the Republic of Slovenia, a professional qualification is obtained upon completion of a six-month post-graduation internship, followed by passing the State Exam with the assistance of an interpreter. The requirement for a post-graduation internship is mandated by Slovenian law. The healthcare institution where the student will complete the internship submits a request to the Ministry of Health of the Republic of Slovenia, along with the internship program. Upon approval, the six-month internship begins, after which the student can schedule the State Exam with the Ministry of Health.

NEW ARTICLE 63.A, DATED MAY 28, 2020, STATES:

"Graduates who complete their studies in the Republic of Slovenia in a language other than Slovene may take the State Exam with the assistance of an interpreter." The costs for the interpreter are the responsibility of the candidate.
